

He says, "It's great to see the community, both individuals and businesses, come together for such a great cause. And the occasional auction battles can get pretty entertaining."

Clayton had two cats, Cricket the Brave (Patchie) and Vixen the Snagglepuss (Sophia), sisters that he adopted from CDHS, who had been illegally abandoned at the shelter after hours. After Vixen passed away, he then adopted Whisper the Wonder Puss (Royseen), so both he and Cricket would have another buddy. He is also currently fostering Dexy, Duchess of the Mist, after she wandered into his yard. He began feeding her and eventually trapped her and brought her to CDHS. She was pretty feral, but healthy, and after the required quarantine period, Clayton took her home in what is sure to be a "foster fail."

As a volunteer and someone who spends a bit of time photographing our shelter pets, Clayton has observed the staff and other volunteers and said he can really see the love they have for the cats and dogs (and parrot) in their care. He can especially relate because of his recent experience socializing Dexy.

Volunteering at CDHS has given Clayton a purpose, and he encourages others to do so. "Seeing your efforts pay off by a pet getting adopted is good for our hearts and souls. Central Dakota is a stellar operation doing great work. Best people doing great work, best people ever, best critters ever!"

Just an update on the kitten. We now call her Sasha, and she is doing very well.




