A Diaper Kitty's Happily-Ever-After Tale

Was he a well-loved kitten who lost his way? Dumped for some reason? Or maybe born a stray?

We'll never know how the little orange kitten came to be in the parking lot where two Good Samaritans found him, injured and in pain. We're grateful they sought help and called CDHS.

The kitten was taken directly to the vet, where his age was estimated at about 6 months and his hind-end injuries were diagnosed as nerve damage and a prolapsed rectum. He was released to CDHS with medications for pain, infection, and to address his urine- and feces-scalded skin.

Rafiki had no feeling in his tail, very little in his genital area, and no tone to his rectum. He was one uncomfortable little stinker, hungry and with a very red, swollen bottom. He quickly became known as "one hot mess," as the prolapse and nerve damage left him incontinent. Whoever cleaned for him each morning faced a kennel that looked like a Jackson Pollock spatter painting – poop was EVERYwhere – on all of the walls, floor, ceiling, blankets... and most of the time, on much of Rafiki himself. Baths were quickly added to his daily routine.

Rafiki's urinary incontinence and "poop-tastrophes" created a learning experience. We tried diapering and quickly learned that he needed a balance of diaper and "nekkid" time to reduce the

mess but not cause diaper rash or other infections.

Over time Rafiki's skin healed, and he became accustomed to his twice-aday trips to the sink for baths. However, he still had no control over his bladder, rectum, or tail, nor had he regained any feeling.

A second opinion was sought, and that vet agreed with the earlier prognosis, but suggested acupuncture as a possibility. Initial treatments seemed promising but had to be stopped at the onset of COVID-19 and its associated precautions.

Rafiki continued to grow and, as he did, he needed more freedom. We developed new routines that provided

more exercise to help strengthen his hind end. Most days he spent mornings in his diaper, playing in a catio when the weather was nice or running the halls and lobby when it was too cold or wet in the catios.

As COVID restrictions began to ease, acupuncture was resumed. Over several months of treatment Rafiki has gained some bladder control and a good deal of rectal control, as well as limited movement – but no measurable feeling – in the top third-to-half of his tail. His gait in his hind legs has also become more normalized.

At some point in this journey, I became Rafiki's primary caregiver and his designated vet appointment transport, cuddling him and keeping him occupied during his acupuncture sessions, and taking him for special treats on the way home.

In July I took the leap and brought him home as a long-term medical foster. Even though it took a bit longer than I expected, Rafiki has fully settled into our household. He plays with his furbrothers, snuggles with my hubby and me, and thinks his canine sibling is a warm, mobile version of his favorite fuzzy blanket.

As of Rafiki's last vet appointment, it was agreed his condition is about as good as it's likely to get. He'll continue acupuncture on a maintenance schedule, only increasing frequency if he seems to be losing ground.

As it is, he knows when he needs to "go," and he uses the litter box – he just doesn't always know if he's not done yet. He spends unsupervised time in our family room in a multi-level kitten playpen, similar to his kennel at CDHS but a lot bigger. When I'm home, he wears a custom diaper made by Fancy Pants 4 Pets (discovered through an online group for cats with paralysis). He's learned to let me know when he needs a diaper change, and when he's ready to go back to his private playpen space.

I should have known early on, when I started calling him "son," that he'd eventually go home with me. And, like the others in our "unique" crew, that it would be to stay. Welcome home, Rafiki – our newest CDHS alumni. We love you and wouldn't have it any other way. •

Shelter Report

Helping as Many as We Can in Many Ways

Everyone talks about the last couple years and how challenging it has been. To some the word

'challenging' is surely an understatement. Most of us know someone who was quite ill or even lost their life, and our lives are forever changed because of it. But like everyone else we all try to live our lives as normally as possible while keeping ourselves (and our loved ones) as safe as we can. Some people are marginally concerned, and others are still terrified and frozen in isolation. This is a new time and circumstances that many of us have never experienced before. Just like with natural disasters and other "acts of God," animals are experiencing the fallout of our current times as well, with some paying the price with their homes, security, and sometimes their lives.

We continue to operate at full capacity, and we know there are many more people and animals that need help – more than we can accommodate. In an earnest effort to help as many as we can we have expanded and changed some of the services we offer. Though we sometimes feel we may be trying to fill a huge hole with just a little putty, we are doing what we can to help animals stay in homes and reduce the burden on their caretakers.

Buddy's Bowl started with the community's generosity in donating dog and cat food to us. We often had enough that we were able to share with individuals in need, or other shelters and rescues. Along with the COVID pandemic came a nationwide trend in animal rescue to help people keep their pets in their homes in an effort to reduce the number of pets coming into shelters and rescues. We decided to formalize our community pet food donations and Buddy's Bowl became a formal program. On a regular basis CDHS staff and volunteers deliver dog and cat food to Ministry on the Margins, Community Action, YMCA, Heavens Helpers Soup Café, and Adopt-A-Block. This pet food as well as other pet related supplies is free for the taking, no judgement, to anyone who needs it. KT Animal Supply, Runnings (Bismarck), Runnings (Mandan), Cash Wise, Target, and Walmart provide us with discounts and donations to help fill Buddy's Bowl. This community program helps our neighbors and friends who are experiencing financial hardship. Keeping pets in homes (and out of shelters and pounds) is vital, not just to the animals but to the human owners that love them dearly. Along with help from our supporters and community, we are hoping to make a big impact right here in our own back yard.

Another change we will start in 2022 is to increase the value of our **Spay/Neuter Assistance Program (SNAP)** coupons. Starting January 1, 2022, the value of the coupons will increase to \$50. We have always maintained that the key to ending dog and cat overpopulation is spay and neuter, so anything we can do to prevent additional litters from being born is a sound

investment! We must attack the overpopulation problem at the root cause, and that is unaltered animals allowed to reproduce thus increasing the struggle for the already grossly overburdened shelter and rescue systems. If you answered our phones for a day, you would know how big the problem is in our community and frankly every community in North Dakota. If you live in New Salem, Hebron, Washburn, Wishek, Judson, Mott, etc., you most likely know of the feral/stray cat problem that is everywhere! It's heartbreaking and a mountain of a problem but doing nothing will not produce the results we all seek. We have to do SOMETHING.

Last year our SNAP coupons assisted more than 900 animals. Different sources reveal different estimates of how many puppies and kittens can be born from one pair of unaltered pets and their offspring, with some estimates reaching more than 300,000 in seven years. Considering that each dog and cat can have multiple litters per year, with multiple offspring in each litter, we would estimate that our SNAP Program has prevented the birth of many thousands of unwanted puppies and kittens each year. All those prevented animals will not be discarded; they will not burden the rescue, impound, and shelter system; they will not starve and freeze in our harsh ND winters.

As happy as we are about the success of the SNAP Program and the fact that we helped make sure 900 animals were altered within a 100-mile radius of CDHS, pet overpopulation still exists. We must continue to battle this problem, and we need your help to do it. Thank you for working with us and providing the resources to be a true caretaker for all of our animal friends.


